Romans 9:1-6

- Paul's Christlike attitude toward the Jews

Vss. 6-7

- The chosen people rejected Jesus as Messiah, but God decides who is chosen.

Vss. 8-9

- Abraham had 2 sons, and the younger was chosen by God (Genesis 18:10,14)

Vss 10-13

- Isaac had 2 sons, and the younger was chosen by God (Genesis 25:21-23 / Malachi 1:2-3)

God's choice was not based on bloodlines or deeds (Romans 8:29-30, Psalm 139:13-16)

Does God's choosing appear unjust to us?
